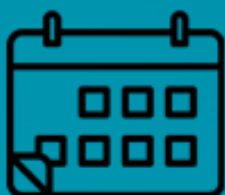


In 2023, the seventy-sixth World Health Assembly (WHA76) will take place in Geneva from 21 to 30 May 2023 with proceedings available via live stream.
