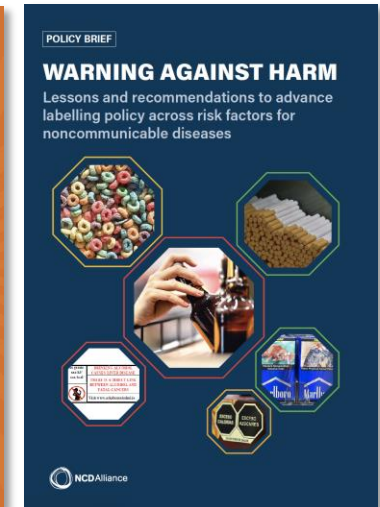
Highlights of 2023: SIDS, NCDs and mental health

- The [Bridgetown Declaration](#) was the main outcome document of the SIDS Ministerial Conference on NCDs and Mental Health (June 2023)
- NCDA inputted into this process in collaboration with the Healthy Caribbean Coalition (HCC)



Highlights of 2023: NCD prevention

- Positively influenced the [update of the WHO Global NCD Action Plan's Appendix 3](#) (a.k.a. NCD 'best buys' and other recommended interventions), with a WHA side event on the prevention 'best buys' and its expansion (May 2023)
- Started implementing our **advocacy on marketing and labelling policies across NCD risk factors** – [Selling a Sick Future](#) and [Warning against Harm](#) publications (October 2023)



Highlights of 2023: NCD financing

- Prepared a shadow Concept Note for the 2nd Global Financing Dialogue on NCDs (2GFD)
 - Shared with driving forces behind 2GFD including WHO, UNIATF, Governments
- OOP spending report with TGI
- Financing case study on UNDP's country investment in the Philippines
- Closed-door roundtable on the sidelines of the UNGA78

Looking towards 2024 and 2025

4th High Level Meeting 2025

“The fourth high-level meeting of the General Assembly on the prevention and control of non-communicable diseases in 2025 will be a **time to reflect on the tragic premature death toll** from NCDs of 15 million people each year since 2015 – and which is projected to reach a total of more than 150 million over the previous decade by 2025.

It will also provide an **opportunity to adopt a new, ambitious and achievable political declaration** on NCDs based on evidence and grounded in human rights that will serve as an **important framework to accelerate the global NCD response from 2025, including achieving the SDGs before 2030, and place countries on a sustainable path into the next decades.** ”

UNSG Report 2024: what we know so far

- Mandated by para 50 of HLM3 Political Declaration for delivery by end of 2024
- WHO DG to prepare 2024 Progress Report on behalf of UNSG, in consultation with Member States
- Regional Consultations to take place June-September 2024...but EURO as early as April 2024
- 2024 Report format will be similar to the format used for the four previous report:
 - Chapter 1: Introduction
 - Chapter 2: Progress towards internationally-agreed targets: Where do we stand? (advances and challenges)
 - Chapter 3: Progress made in fulfilling the assignments given to WHO
 - Chapter 4: Progress made in fulfilling the commitments made by Member States
 - Chapter 5: Progress made in strengthening international cooperation
 - Chapter 6: Recommendations for consideration by Member States during the negotiations on the 2025 political declaration on NCDs
 - Annex: Individual county data on the 10 progress indicators set out in the technical note published by WHO on 1 May 2017.

HLM4 Political Declaration

- Will be informed by
 - UNSG Report 2024 recommendations
 - An initial decision reviewed by EB156 in January 2025
 - A decision taken at WHA78 in May 2025
 - A multi-stake-holder hearing in Q2 2025 (likely)
- A zero draft is likely to be produced around WHA78 (likely soon after)
- Final draft negotiated May-August 2025

Modalities Resolution

- Negotiated by Member States under auspices of two co-facilitators appointed by President of the UNGA
- To be adopted at the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA) covering:
 - Scope
 - Modalities
 - Format
 - Organization
 - Date
- Same two co-facilitators will lead the negotiation of the HLM4 political declaration
- Timing not clear likely Q4 2024 but could be even later

HLM4: Main Steps for Policy Development

Main steps

- Initial membership survey on priorities for HLM4 – Q1 2024
- Consultation webinars (via PLAN on an Inclusive Agenda) with membership – Q1 2024
- Prioritisation survey – Q1 2024
- Consult with NCDA Board Policy & Programme Committee
- "Soft launch" of priorities at WHA77 Geneva in May 2024
- Campaign launch at Global Forum, Kigali in October 2024

Accountability

- Support engagement in UNSG Progress Report Regional Consultations
- NCDA narrative and briefings on global progress against targets
- Policy development:
 - NCD targets beyond 2025 and 2030
 - Accountability mechanisms

Looking towards 2024 and 2025: NCD Care

- **Policy paper on NCDs in Humanitarian settings**
- **International Negotiation Body** (WHO Pandemic Agreement adopted in May)

Looking towards 2024 and 2025: NCD prevention

- Policy report on **fiscal policies** across NCD risk factors – to also feed into both the 2GFD and 4HLM
- Ongoing dissemination and outreach efforts for our **marketing and labelling policies** work
- Expecting progress on WHO’s Global **CDOH** Report (and potentially Global CDOH Conference)
- **FCTC COP10** postponed to 2024 (Panama),
- **UNFCCC COP29** to hopefully keep a health focus (Eastern Europe TBC)
- **World Cancer Congress** (Geneva, 17-19 September 2024)
- **WHO Global Conference on Air Pollution and Health** (Accra, 28 October-1 November 2024)
- Preparations ahead of the next **Nutrition for Growth Summit** (Paris, late 2024 or early 2025 TBC)

- **PLAN on NCD Prevention** – what we are projecting:
 - Consultation on fiscal policies policy report
 - Consultation on WHO’s nutrition policy guidelines (food labelling still pending)

Looking towards 2024 and 2025: NCD financing

- 2nd Global Financing Dialogue on NCDs (*tbc June*)
 - Engaging MS and stakeholders at regional consultations and at Dialogue itself
 - Key messages/takeaways to inform HLM4 priorities
- Set of **knowledge products** leading up to the 2GFD
 - Integrating NCD/UHC Financing – discussion paper and UNGA event report
 - OECD Data Flows Report
 - Fiscal measures report
 - *Everybody's Business* – wrapping the financing case study series
 - NCDA Policy Brief
 - G20 investment research and recommendations (*tbc*)
- PLAN call to **support CSO engagement** in the 2GFD consultation process
- Convening stakeholders on the sidelines of high-level processes (WHA, WB Spring Meetings, H20)
 - Includes strategic roundtable event on NCD financing at WHA
