# Who we are

NCD Alliance (NCDA) is a unique global network of hundreds of civil society organisations committed to advancing the prevention and control of noncommunicable diseases (NCDs). NCDA member organisations represent a broad community of diseases, risk factors and global health areas. NCDA, together with its members, drives collective action to advance the NCD agenda. We leverage the voice of people living with NCDs to achieve policy change and to ensure representativeness at all levels around the world.

# Our members

NCDA offers two paid membership categories: Full and Associate. Full members and Associate members pay an annual membership fee and have access to our membership activities and benefits.

## Full membership

Full members are civil society organisations (CSOs) - such as national and international non-governmental organisations, national and regional NCD alliances, national societies, patient organisations and networks, professional societies and academic institutions - who are actively engaged in NCD prevention and control and align with NCDA's goals. Full members have priority access to the full range of membership activities and benefits.

## Associate membership

Associate members are CSOs (listed as above) who are engaged in the NCD response and support NCDA's goals. Associate members have lower priority access to membership activities and benefits compared to Full members.

## Network membership

NCDA aims to make membership as accessible as possible through network membership, which requires no annual fee payment. However, network members do not receive access to the range of membership activities and benefits.

### Exchange knowledge, policy and advocacy intelligence

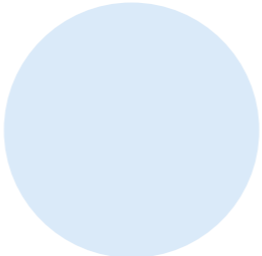

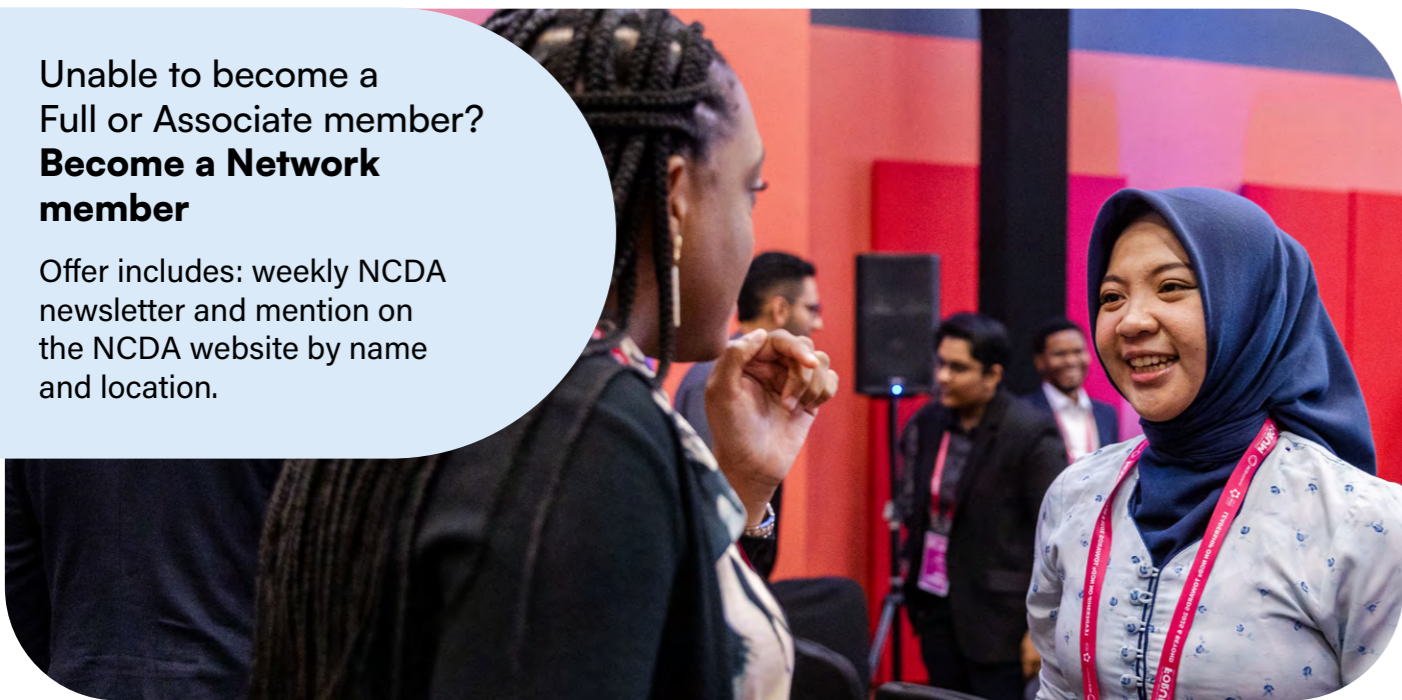
