## *Driving SDG progress on health – learning cycles towards NCD care for all*

Reducing non-communicable disease (NCD) morbidity and mortality is critical to reaching the goals and targets of the WHO Action Plan for the Prevention and Control of NCDs and the SDGs. Meanwhile, many people around the world face multiple barriers to accessing the care they need to manage their condition. This has severe consequences on both a personal and societal level.
