# **LOOKING BACK AT HLM3**



2018 Thirty-Ninth Regular Meeting of the Conference of Heads of Government of the Caribbean Community (CARICOM)

Heads of Government endorsed six priorities on which the Region should advocate for during the negotiation of the Outcome Document.

They commended the contribution of civil society organisations to regional efforts to counter NCDs.
