WHY DO WE NEED ADF?

In most low-income countries, and some middle-income countries, most people with asthma are undiagnosed, untreated or poorly treated, due to:

- low availability of essential medicines
- high prices of these medicines
- unstandardised diagnosis and treatment
- poor quality of care
- inequitable access to care
- low awareness and commitment
- asthma rarely being treated at primary care level by general health services



4 STEP APPROACH TO ASTHMA with HFA inhalers (CFC-free)

Diagnosis and treatment based on symptoms and lung function

	HFA-Beclometasone 100 µg*
Severe	8 puffs /day
Moderate	4 puffs /day
Mild	2 puffs /day
Intermittent	0 puffs /day

* And HFA-Salbutamol 100 µg as needed
