Global NCD Framework Campaign

Global NCD Framework – Priorities

Three WHO-led processes:

- 1. Global GMF and NCD Targets:** Support development of an ambitious set of global targets to drive and monitor progress on NCD prevention and control
- 2. Global NCD Action Plan 2013-2020:** Influence scope and ambition of Global NCD Action Plan with integrated monitoring framework, targets and indicators
- 3. Global Coordinating Mechanism:** Support development of a multisectoral platform to mobilise political leadership and resources

GMF and Targets – Timeline

2012

- **25 Jul 2012 – 19 Oct 2012:** WHO 3rd Discussion Paper released. Online consultation open to NGOs and selected private sector entities to submit online responses

2012

- **Sept – Oct 2012:** Discussions at the WHO Regional Committee Meetings

2012

- **End of Oct 2012:** WHO Secretariat publish a report summarizing outcomes of WHO Regional Committee discussions/online consultation

2012

- **5-7 Nov 2012:** Formal meeting with Member States and UN agencies to conclude GMF/targets

2013

- **Jan 2013:** WHO Secretariat will submit a report on the final recommendations to the Executive Board

2013

- **May 2013:** WHO Secretariat will submit a report with the final recommendations to the World Health Assembly

NCD Framework – Global NCD Plan Timeline

2012

- **26 Jul 2012 – 7 Sept 2012:** WHO Discussion Paper on Global Plan released. Online consultation open to NGOs and selected private sector entities to submit online responses.

2012

- **16-17 Aug 2012:** First Informal Consultation with Member States and UN agencies on Global Plan

2012

- **10 Oct-1 Nov 2012:** WHO Annotated Zero Draft Action Plan released. Online consultation open to NGOs and selected private sector entities to submit online responses

2012

- **1 Nov 2012:** Second Informal Consultation with Member States and UN agencies

2013

- **Jan 2013:** Annotated Draft Action Plan submitted to WHO Executive Board

2013

- **March 2013:** Third Informal Consultation with Member States and UN agencies

GMF and Targets – Regional Highlights

- **SEARO:** Resolution adopted, including support for 4 major risk factors, as well as health system targets (essential medicines and drug therapy)
- **EURO:** Resolution adopted, stressing importance of addressing health inequity in the GMF
- **WPRO:** Support for 4 major risk factor targets, and indicators on cervical cancer and eliminating trans-fats
- **PAHO:** Regional Strategy on NCDs adopted, including a comprehensive set of regional targets
- **EMRO:** Comprehensive EMRO paper, urging governments to adopt national NCD plans by 2013
- **AFRO Workshop:** Strong support for health system targets, particularly essential medicines target
- **AFRO:** 19-22 November, Angola

NCD Alliance Response to GMF and GAP on NCDs

- **Aug:** Advocacy briefing paper on GMF and targets
Advocacy briefing paper on Global Action Plan, sent to Missions in New York and Geneva
- **Sept – Oct:** Formal submission GMF and GAP
- **Oct-Nov:** Meetings with Missions; summary of submission, engage Member States
- **1 Nov:** Formal response to Zero Draft of GAP
- **Nov 1-7:** Present during formal consultations
- **Jan – March - May:** Keep up advocacy through to World Health Assembly

GMF and Targets – Key Recommendations

1. Establish and resource a robust global monitoring framework
2. Adopt comprehensive set of bold targets to drive progress towards “25 by 25”
3. Strike a balance between targets on prevention, treatment and care
4. Agree a rigorous reporting system, including national reporting every two years to WHA and UNGA
5. Support the application of global targets to regional and national levels

4	Reduce NCD risk factors and create sustainable and health-promoting environments			
5	Improve care for people with NCDs through strengthened health systems and universal health coverage			
6	Implement the prioritized NCD research agenda and improve NCD surveillance and reporting systems

- **19 Oct 2012:** UNSG paper with recommendations released

- **28 Nov 2012:** UN General Assembly discussion on global partnership paper

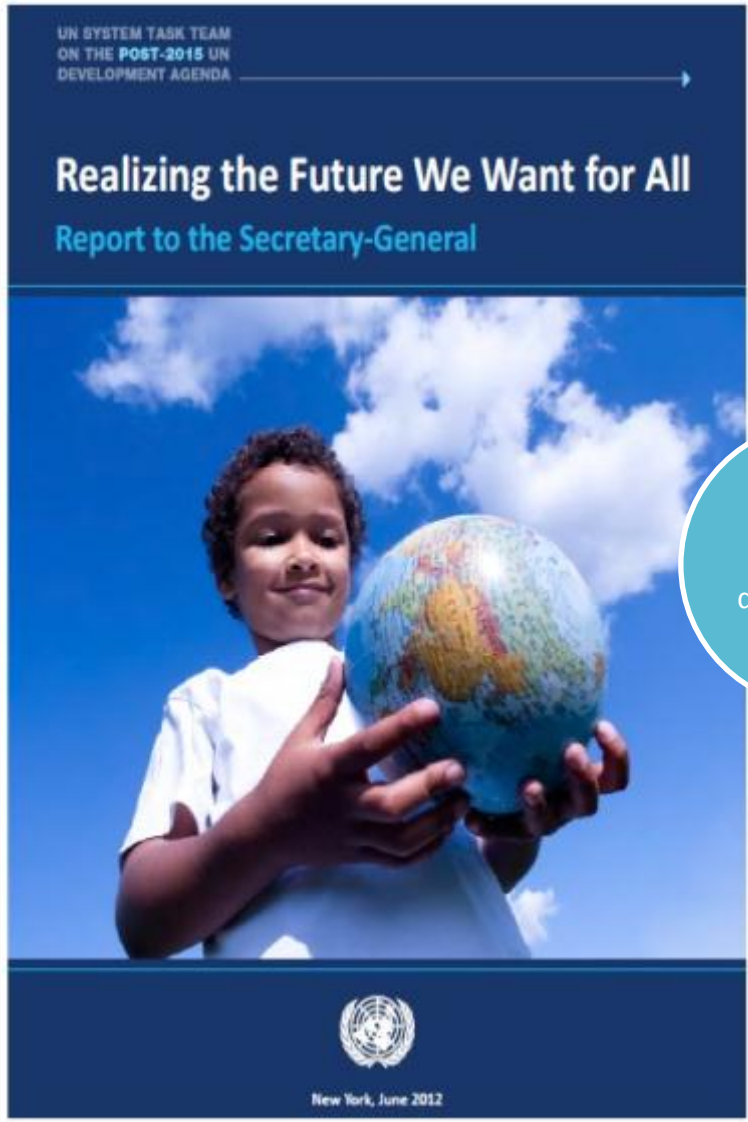

Post-2015: National Consultations

- 100 national consultations over next 12 months
- Coordinated by UNDP on behalf of UN Development Group
- **Goal:** Produce clear recommendations for governments
- Led by UN Resident Coordinators
- 3 outputs:
 - Executive summary
 - Full report
 - Contributing components (e.g. think pieces)
- Ministries of Health may be involved

Global Thematic Consultation on Health

- Led by WHO and UNICEF
- Coordinated by governments of Sweden and Botswana
- Feb/March 2013 – exact date still not set
- WHO issued call for papers
 - 5 questions on health and MDGs, post-2015
 - Deadline: **15 December**
- UN System launched call for proposals from civil society orgs to hold consultations on health in post-2015 agenda
- Beyond2015 developing civil society position paper on health
 - Led by Medicus Mundi
 - Deadline: **5 November**

Sustainable Development Goals – Parallel Process



UN Secretary-General:

"The Panel's work will be closely coordinated with that of the intergovernmental working group tasked to design Sustainable Development Goals, as agreed at the Rio +20 conference."

Objective:

Tasked to develop a proposal for the Sustainable Development Goals

Members:

Working Group comprised of 30 representatives nominated by Member States (September 2012)

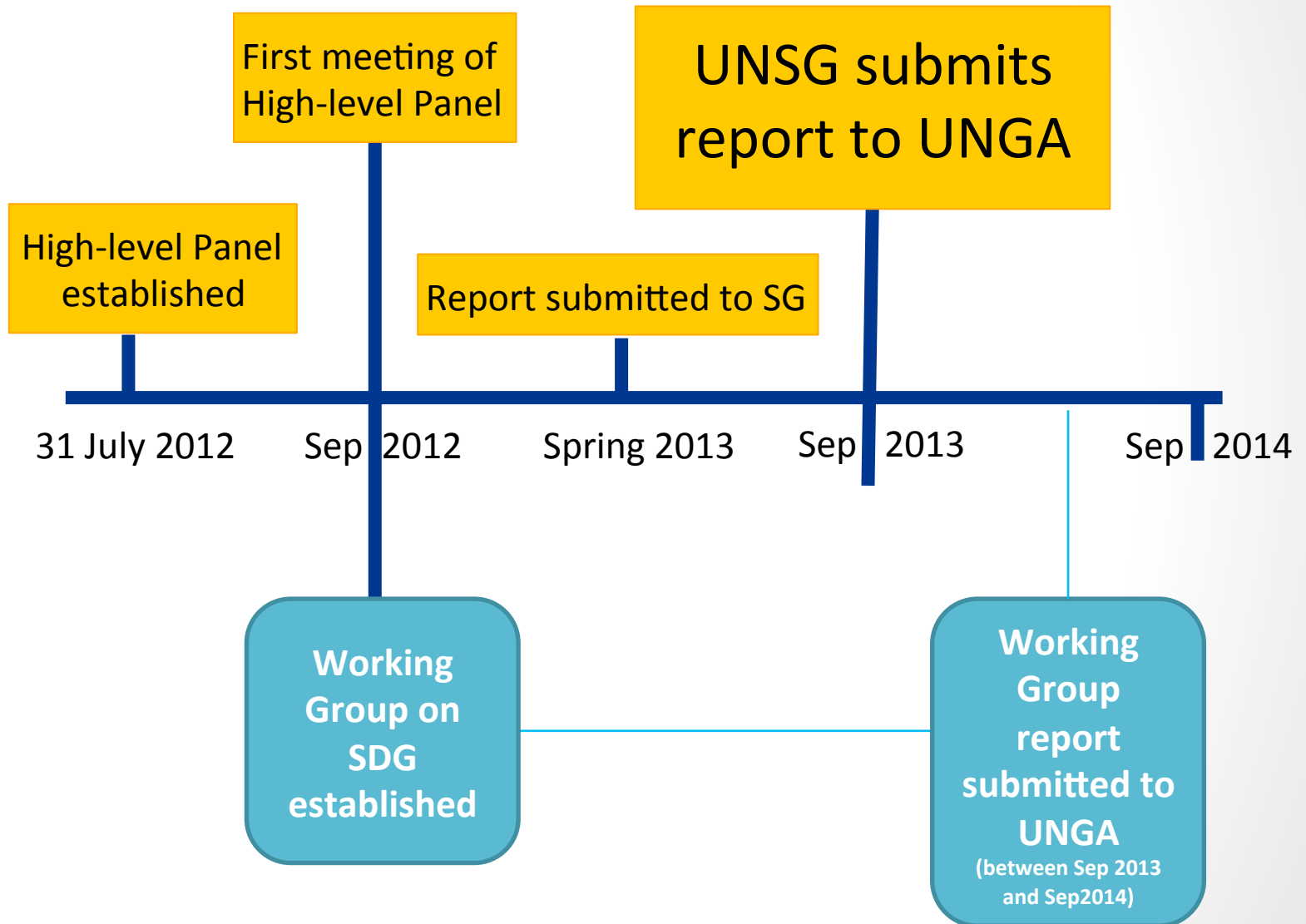
Output:

A report to the UNGA containing a proposal for sustainable development goals (Sept 2013-2014)

Mandated by Rio+20 Outcome Doc

NCD Alliance e-consultation

- Stimulate a discussion on health and NCDs as they relate to the MDGs and post-2015 development agenda, and critical issues therein (e.g. UHC, population, etc)
- Develop a common position on asks and must-haves for health and NCDs in the new post-2015 development framework **to be submitted in the form of a “think piece” to WHO for 15 December deadline**
- Generate additional advocacy material for the NCD Alliance to use in our Global Development Campaign

NCD Alliance e-consultation

- Open from 1 November
- Consultation will be set up through Survey Monkey and accessed through the NCD Alliance website
- Respondents to answer questions on a rating scale; open-ended answers also possible
- Can be completed in one of three languages – English, French and Spanish and will take **10-15 min** to complete.
- **DEADLINE: 19 November**
